Method of Running the Ted Peirce Singles, St Raphael's Mixed Pairs, Men's Blesma Pairs, and the Ladies Blesma Pairs

1. The competition rules can be found on the Association's website (www.suttonanddistrictba.co.uk)
2. The entry forms will typically be made available end March / early April, and will be circulated by the Hon. Secretary to Club Secretaries and Delegates. They will also be available on the website.
3. Entrants must use the official entry form and return this and the requisite entry fees as directed on the form by the defined date, typically mid May.
4. The draw will be made by officers of the Association, usually in 3rd week of May. The Honorary Secretary will e-mail the competition draws to Club Secretaries and Delegates.
5. Contact details and the competition draw sheet will be sent to all entrants – either by the Hon. Secretary or by the individual Competition Secretary. It is the responsibility of the entrants to arrange their matches. If an entrant is concerned that he/she has not received appropriate information regarding their opponent and their contact details, it is the entrant's responsibility to raise this promptly with the Competition Secretary.
6. The Winner of each match must phone the Competition Secretary with the match result and score before 10.00pm on the day the match is played, and confirmed by email by the following day.

The Competition Secretary will advise the winner of their next opponent as soon as the opponent is known.
7. After the close of each round of the competition, the updated draw sheets will be e-mailed to Club Secretaries and Delegates.
8. The updated draw sheets will also be posted on the 'Competitions' page of the S&DBA website.
9. Scorecards signed by both competitors to be retained by the Winner up to and including Finals Day or until knocked-out of the competition.
